

Based on true events that inspired a generation of young Norwegians, writer/director Ole Giæver's elegant, multi award-winning drama follows a young woman who is unintentionally drawn into a protest against a dam that may flood Indigenous Sámi land. Summer, 1979. Recently graduated, 23-year-old schoolteacher Ester (magnetic newcomer Ella Marie Hætta Isaksen) moves to the northern Norwegian town of Alta. Like many Sámi – the native people of Scandinavia – Ester is ashamed of her heritage and conceals her ethnicity to fit in.

When her cousin Mihkkal (Gard Emil), who openly embraces his roots, takes Ester to see a riverside camp where a group is demonstrating against the government's plan to build a hydroelectricity plant, she slowly begins to understand that the conflict is about more than environmental concerns – her very identity and culture is being challenged. Knowing what is at stake, Ester is stirred to act, placing herself and her loved ones at risk. A moving story about finding one's voice, *Let the River Flow* powerfully depicts the events that led to a turning point in the fight for Sámi rights.

Award winning writer/director Hlynur Pálmason's much anticipated follow-up to his breakout hit *A White, White Day* is a stunning historical drama of a Danish priest who goes on a pilgrimage across a largely unexplored Iceland in the late 1800s. Lucas (Elliot Crosset Hove, *Wildland SCA21*), an idealistic but naïve young Lutheran clergyman, is on his way to a remote part of Iceland to build a church and photograph its people. With the help of a translator and a guide (Ingvar E. Sigurðsson, *A White, White Day SCA19*), he must journey across the spectacular and dangerous terrain, littered with glaciers and rivers. But the deeper he goes into the unforgiving landscape, the more he strays from his purpose, the mission and morality, with unexpected and shocking repercussions. Recalling such landmark films as Werner Herzog's *Aguirre, the Wrath of God* and P.T. Anderson's *There Will Be Blood*, Pálmason captures the unwelcome priest's perilous journey in haunting detail and artistry. With evocative cinematography that mirrors the characters' obsession to document a strange new environment, their worlds, ideas and language collide with enthralling impact.

Fresh from being awarded the Jury Prize at the 2023 Cannes Film Festival, this beguiling new comedic romance from celebrated auteur Aki Kaurismäki (*The Other Side of Hope SCA17*) follows two lost souls who meet by chance in the Helsinki night. Ansa (Alma Pöysti, *Tove SCA21*) works at a supermarket, where the job is so badly paid that she takes home expired sandwiches for dinner. Holappa (Jussi Vatanen) is a metalworker, labouring in a job so hazardous he drinks through the day and again at night to cope. Meanwhile, the radio constantly carries news about the nearby war in Ukraine.

One evening, Holappa is dragged to a karaoke bar by a friend and when he meets shy Ansa, there is an immediate spark. But life being what it is, a variety of obstacles conspire to get in the way. With his trademark deadpan humour, minimalist dialogue and retro aesthetic, Kaurismäki's latest delight showcases his unrivalled mastery for depicting down-on-their-luck characters in all their complexity and finding humour in the unlikely of circumstances.

15 years since it sank its teeth into cinemas, *Let the Right One In* continues to be a subversive piece of romantic horror, haunting audiences with atmospheric cinematography and subdued yet powerful performances. Exploring various themes such as friendship, love, loneliness and the darker side of human nature, the film skillfully combines elements of horror, romance, and a classic coming-of-age story.

Set in the early 1980s in a suburb of Stockholm and based on the 2004 novel of the same title by John Ajvide Lindqvist, we meet Oskar, a 12-year-old boy who is frequently bullied at school. One night, he meets a peculiar girl named Eli who moves into the apartment next door, and the bond that forms changes their lives forever.

Praised for its unique take on the vampire genre (never actually uttering the V-Word in the film), atmospheric storytelling, and exploration of themes beyond the supernatural, *Let the Right One In* eclipses the boundaries of genre to become a classic among fans of horror and art-house cinema alike.

From internationally acclaimed director Birgitte Stærmosé (*Industry*, *The English Game*, *The Spanish Princess*), *Camino* is a wryly humorous drama about family baggage and connections.

Deep down, Regitze (Danica Curcic, *The Exception SCA21*, also in *Unruly*) has never felt completely accepted at home for being who she truly is. Now in her early 30s, she finds herself with no job, no partner, no children and she is also no longer on speaking terms with her father Jan (Lars Brygmann, *Riders of Justice*, *Borgen*).

Yet when father and daughter discover that Regitze's mother's dying wish was for them to reconnect and follow the famous Camino de Santiago pilgrimage trail together, the two set out on the 260-kilometre journey. Under the blistering Spanish sun, they find their complex relationship challenged in new ways.

Set against the spectacular backdrop of Spain's Camino de Santiago, this poignant drama is an emotional story about our deepest bonds, and the struggles of feeling different from our family.

Director's Note: "Processing and dealing with baggage from our upbringing is part of being alive. For this reason, I think that 'Camino' is a very universal story that will be relevant for many people."

An intriguing psychological drama about isolation, *Copenhagen Does Not Exist* revolves around a radical and unconventional love story between two complex people. Young woman Ida (Angela Bundalovic, *Copenhagen Cowboys*) disappears without a trace. Three months later, her boyfriend Sander (newcomer Jonas Holst Schmidt) voluntarily agrees to an unusual arrangement: to be locked in an apartment and interrogated by Ida's father (Zlatko Burić, *Triangle of Sadness*) and brother to uncover what really happened, but Sander does not reveal all.

It soon becomes clear that long before her disappearance, the two lovers had chosen a strange and unconventional life: choosing to cut themselves off from the world in the search for intimacy, the couple isolated themselves in the middle of the big city. Based on the novel *Sander* by Norwegian author Terje Holtet Larsen and with a screenplay by Oscar-nominated screenwriter and director Eskil Vogt (*The Worst Person in the World*) Martin Skovbjerg's second feature explores the power of memories and how grief alters our reality.

From critically acclaimed director Fenar Ahmad comes pulsating action thriller *Darkland: The Return*, the highly anticipated successor to the Danish box office smash hit *Darkland SCA17*, starring an excellent Dar Salim (*The Covenant*). It has been seven years since surgeon Zaid went on a revenge spree in the criminal underworld, to avenge his brother's death. Since then, Zaid has been in prison and become a father to son Noah (Asgar Hansen), whom he barely knows. So, when police agent Helle (Birgitte Hjort Sørensen, *Borgen*) offers him a deal to go undercover and infiltrate the Copenhagen underworld, in exchange for being released and seeing his estranged seven-year-old son, he jumps at the chance to be reunited with his family.

Zaid tries to keep his life as an undercover source in a violent gang separate from the relationship he is building with his son, but eventually the two worlds collide, and he must do everything he can to protect him.

Things are seemingly fine until rumors of a rebellion begin to swirl. Which side are Anna and Petrine really on – and is it the same?

Direct from the 2023 Göteborg Film Festival, *Empire* was conceived and written by Anna Neye, who also stars in the film's lead role and directed by Frederikke Aspöck. A mix of earnest drama and absurd comedy, it deliberately places female Afro-Caribbean characters at the centre of the story. Exploring power dynamics and human interdependence, *Empire* delivers a challenge to Denmark's romanticised vision of its past.

Creative couple Stine (Marie Bach Hansen, *The Last Vermeer*) and Teit (Mikkel Boe Følsgaard, *Land of Mine SCA16*, *A Royal Affair*) have decided to leave the urban life in Copenhagen behind, and with their young son Nemo, retreat to a remote cabin in the middle of a Swedish forest. Trading the comforts of the city for a new life in a sustainable shelter, they hope to reignite the spark in their relationship and find themselves as individuals, while documenting their new lifestyle in a podcast series.

One day Nemo disappears into the woods, but when he is later found, he is strangely frightened of Stine, insisting that she is not his mother. As their new surroundings begin to become increasingly hostile, old grudges and selfish desires begin to take over, forcing them to confront their own egos. A layered and haunting dramatic thriller with a supernatural element, Danish director Karoline Lyngbye's slick feature film debut reflects on the couple's fears, desires and the importance of trust.

Directed by Danish comedy queen Hella Joof (*Happy Ending SCA19*) and based on the bestselling and award-winning eponymous novel by Stine Pilgaard, *The Land of Short Sentences* is a warm-hearted modern comedy about belonging and community.

When the love of her life, Rasmus (Thomas Hwan, *Persona Non Grata SCA21*), takes on a teaching job at a local school in West Jutland, Denmark, Marie's (Sofie Torp, *A Taste of Hunger SCA22*) life is turned upside down. Rather unwillingly, Marie agrees to join Rasmus in the move from her beloved Copenhagen to the windy West Jutland town, Velling.

While Rasmus immediately adapts to the local ways, Marie experiences a culture shock, finding her social skills depleted, and time and time again she proves herself a misfit to the locals. But, as she slowly learns to listen more and talk less, she comes to realise that she might need the small community as much as Velling needs her – and her advice column for the local newspaper.

Crowned best Nordic film at the 2023 Göteborg Film Festival, *Unruly* is an unsettling historical drama inspired by real-life events from the notorious women's institution on the Danish Island of Sprogø in the 1930s. Seventeen-year-old Maren (Emilie Kroyer Koppel, *Happy Ending SCA19*) is a strong-minded young woman, who is seen by authorities to be ill-mannered and promiscuous. Concerned that her unruly behavior will incite others, she is sent away to a women's institution on the small island of Sprogø, where “morally feeble” girls and women were sent to become more compliant. Here she is to learn how to behave as a proper young woman, under a strict regime led by director Nielsen (Lene Maria Christensen, *The Exception SCA21*).

She must share a room with Sørine, one of the director's favourites, who has already internalised the story about herself and has learned to behave properly. Sørine helps Maren to settle in Sprogø and change her behaviour, but Maren's refusal to comply with the system sparks consequences for both.

One day he crashes his beloved car, a bright red 1972 Ford Escort. When he decides to buy a new car, he is extremely particular and has to have another 1972 Escort, but the closest one available is in Germany, where coincidentally his brother Tarmo (who he lost touch with) moved decades ago. So, he withdraws all his money from the bank, stashes it in a suitcase, and heads off for Germany.

After a series of incidents, the previously estranged brothers are reunited and decide to look for an Escort together, getting to know each other again in the process. Moving between tragedy and comedy, with dry, laconic humour, *The Grump: In Search of an Escort* is a feel-good story about reconciliation and forgiveness.
